


Go on a bug hunt

Looking for and finding bugs (insects, worms, snails etc) can be an interesting and fun way to learn about wildlife!

Bugs are very delicate so they must be handled very carefully. A paint brush can be used to encourage insects into a pot and remember to put them back where you found them.

Step 1: collect some useful equipment.

- Paint brush
- Small pot
- Teaspoon
- White sheet
- Insect id guide



Step 2: go to a local park or greenspace.



Step 3: look under small logs.



Step 6: after rain look out for worms and snails.



Step 5: search through long grass.



Step 4: look under leaves.
